### CX Print Server 1.5 for the Xerox 700 Digital Color Press

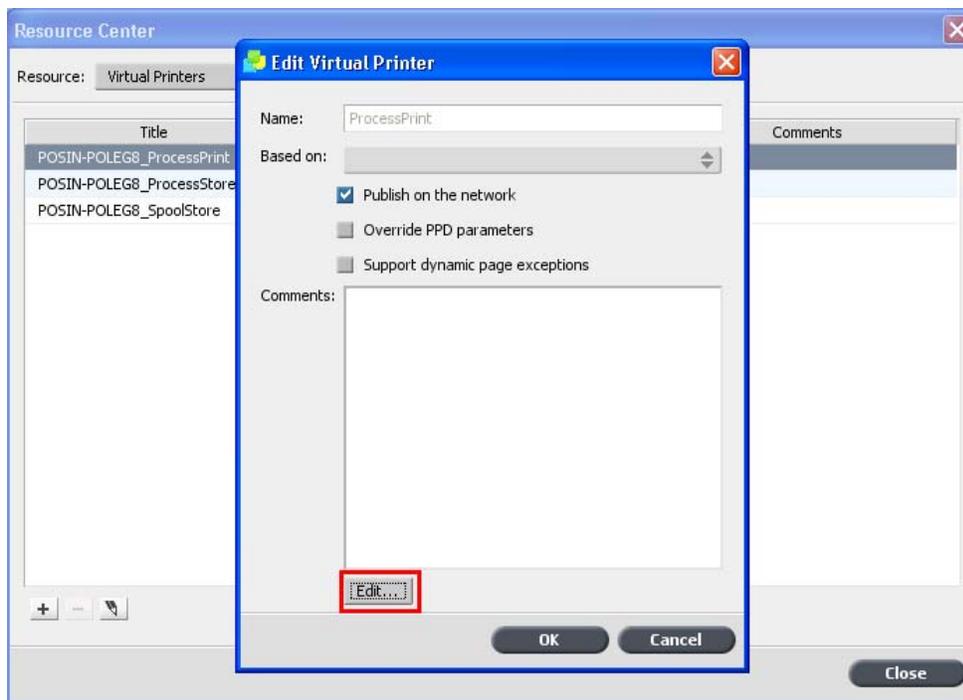
#### Problem description

Files that include a grayscale image print as color documents, and are therefore charged as color documents.

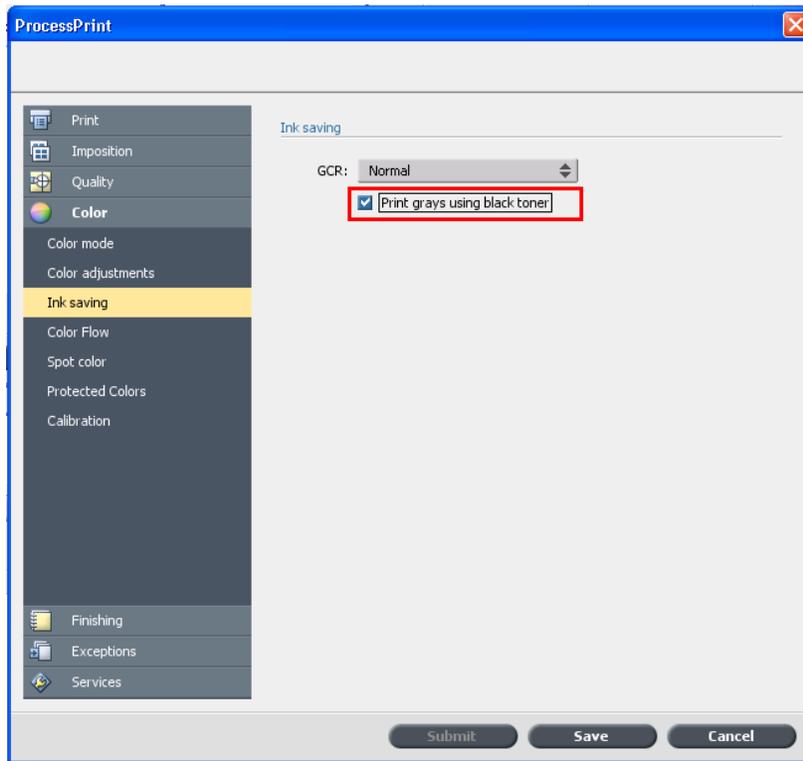
#### Solution

Change the default color settings for the virtual printer.

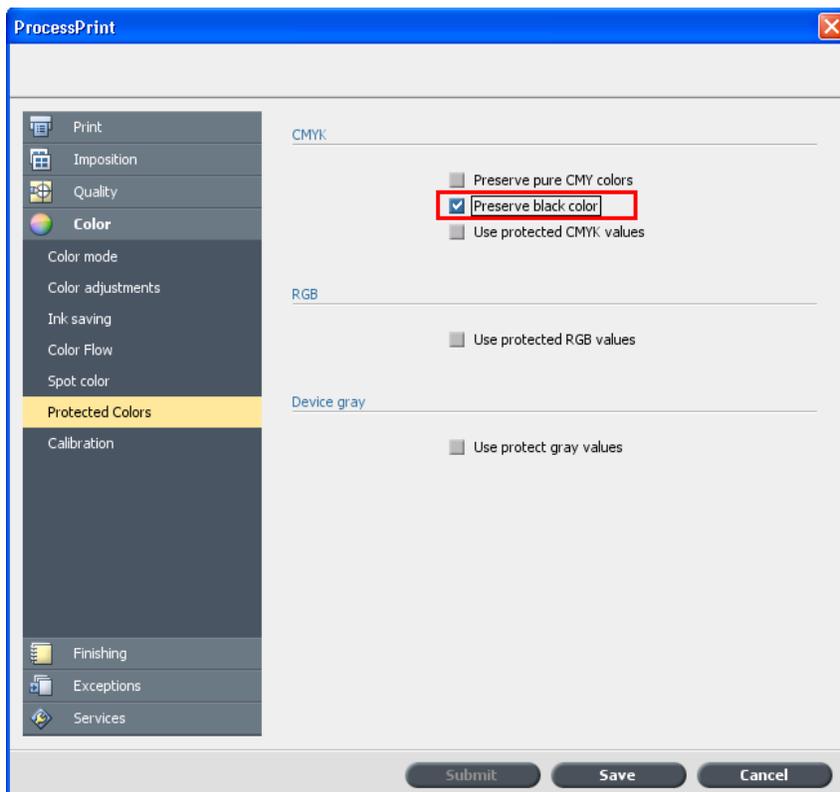
1. Open the Resource Center window, and then double-click the virtual printer that you want to edit.
2. In the Edit Virtual Printer dialog box, click **Edit**.



3. Under **Color**, select the **Ink saving** parameter, and then select the **Print grays using black toner**.



4. Select the **Protected Colors** parameter, and then select the **Preserve black color** check box.



5. Click **Save**, and then close the Edit virtual printer dialog box.
