Before Installation:

Record the following information for use during setup at the DC220/230:

Note: The DC220/230 will attach itself to the default zone of the local segment where it is connected.

- Connect the DC220/230 to your network outlet or cable.
- 2. Enter System Administrator Setups:
 - a) Press the [Access] button on the Control Panel.
 - b) Enter the System Administrator password by typing #22222 (# key and 22222) on the keypad and pressing [Enter] on the screen.

Note: #22222 is the factory default password and may be changed by your Xerox service representative to suit your needs.

- **3.** Access the AppleTalk Setup screens:
 - a) On the screen display, press [Print Setups].
 - b) Press [Network Setups].
 - c) Press [AppleTalk].
- **4.** Enable AppleTalk:
 - a) Press [Enablement].
 - b) Press [Enabled].
 - C) Press [Printer Name], then press [Edit] and use the keyboard displayed on the screen to enter the Printer Name for your network (31 characters, or less).
- 5. Press [Save].
- D. Press [Save].
- Press [Exit]. The DC220/230 will reboot and print a configuration sheet in approximately 3 minutes.
- 8. Check the settings on the configuration sheet against those that were entered.

- To install the DC220/230 Macintosh[®] PPD:
 - a) Copy the DC220/230 Macintosh PPD from the CentreWare[®] CD to the System Folder/Extensions/Printer Descriptions folder.
 - **b)** Set up and configure the Print Driver via the Chooser.
 - c) Refer to the CentreWare[®] manual, Getting Started with Print and Fax Services for additional information.
