

Problem: The Splash Server does not appear on AppleTalk

Cause: OS X and Classic are set up for different AppleTalk zones. Classic does not honor the OS X zone selection. It uses the default zone on the network instead.

Workaround: Change the OS X system preferences to match the zone Classic is using

#### Procedure

- 1) Expand the "WhatZoneIsClassicUsing.sit" archive
- 2) Double-click the "WhatZoneIsClassicUsing" app. The app displays a dialog with the name of the zone Classic is using. Remember it or write it down.
- 3) Select the Cancel button to quit the app.
- 4) Open the System Preferences
- 5) Open the Network pane
- 6) Select the AppleTalk tab
- 7) Change the "AppleTalk Zone:" menu selection to the one reported in Step 2.
- 8) Quit the System Preferences
- 9) A dialog prompts whether to apply the configuration changes. Select "Apply"
- 10) Restart the Mac

When the Splash Server launches next, it will appear in the Chooser on OS 9 and in Print Center on OS X.
