If the edge of the jammed paper can be reached at the output tray, pull the jammed paper in the direction of the feed-out area.



Tray 5 (Bypass)Inspect the inside (paper feed entrance) of Tray 5 (Bypass), and remove any jammed paper.




Fig. 7 **Duplex Module Cover**Remove the jammed paper.




Fig. 8 **Bottom left cover**Remove the jammed paper.
